

An adjourned meeting of the Council of the City of Bedford, Virginia, from the May 13, 2003, regular meeting was held in the Council Hall of the Municipal Building at 6:30 p.m., May 27, 2003.

Members present: Mayor E. Thomas Messier; Councilwoman Mary L. Flood; Councilman Jeffrey B. Hubbard; Councilman Thomas M. Padgett; Councilman C. G. Stanley, Jr.; and Councilman Robert T. Wandrei.

Members absent: Vice Mayor W. D. Tharp

Staff present: City Manager F. Craig Meadows; W. W. Berry, IV, City Attorney; and Clerk of the Council Teresa W. Hatcher.

Mayor Messier opened the meeting.

Council proceeded to hold a work session on the proposed FY 2003-04 budget.

The City Manager briefly reviewed highlights of the General Fund.

Council discussed items in the General Fund: inclusion of the Main Street Director in the City's budget; why the Youth Connections Dance is included in the Police Department's budget instead of the Recreation Department's budget; spring and fall cleanup; and problems with refuse disposal at the dumpsters behind the Municipal Building.

Mayor Messier referred the following items to the Solid Waste Committee for recommendation: possible elimination of the dumpsters behind the Municipal Building and possible elimination of one of the cleanups.

Mayor Messier adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
