The organization bears full responsibility for crowd control and for individual behavior of those present. A responsible member of the organization shall be present throughout the use of the facility to see that the property is protected and that conditions of use are not exceeded.
- The sale of food, drinks or any commodity is prohibited unless specifically requested and approved. No alcoholic beverages allowed without permission of the Bedford City Council. If permission is granted, a permit to serve alcohol must be obtained from the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
- No illegal substances, firearms, fireworks or glass containers are allowed in the Recreation facilities.
- The City Recreation Department reserves final right of action on any use request for any valid reason and reserve the final right to revoke any permit for false or misleading statements on an application.
